Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that *Symmetry* is now inviting nominations for the *Symmetry* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of symmetry/asymmetry phenomena wherever they occur in all aspects of natural sciences. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Sergei Odintsov.

**The Prize:**

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Symmetry* after peer review before the end of 31 December 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

**Eligibility and Requirements:**

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of symmetry/asymmetry phenomena;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

**List of Documents for Nomination:**

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

**Schedule:**

- Open for nomination: 16 January 2023
- Nomination deadline: 31 October 2023
- Winner announcement: 31 December 2023
