While the various issues addressed in this publication are diverse, the collective contribution included in this Special Edition demonstrates a notable coherence. encompassing a diverse spectrum of emerging research and policy recommendations from scholars in nine countries across three continents. This publication also addresses global resistance, highlighting the "periphery's potency" as embodied in grassroots agency and various forms of resistance emerging worldwide, as well as strategies to promote socioeconomic and racial justice.
