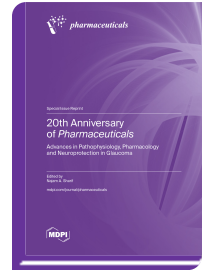
20th Anniversary of *Pharmaceuticals*
