



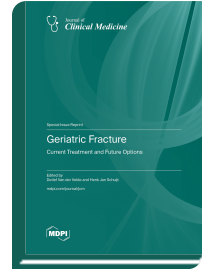
Special Issue Reprint

Geriatric Fracture
