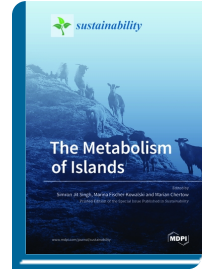

This book makes the case for why we should care about islands and their sustainability.
