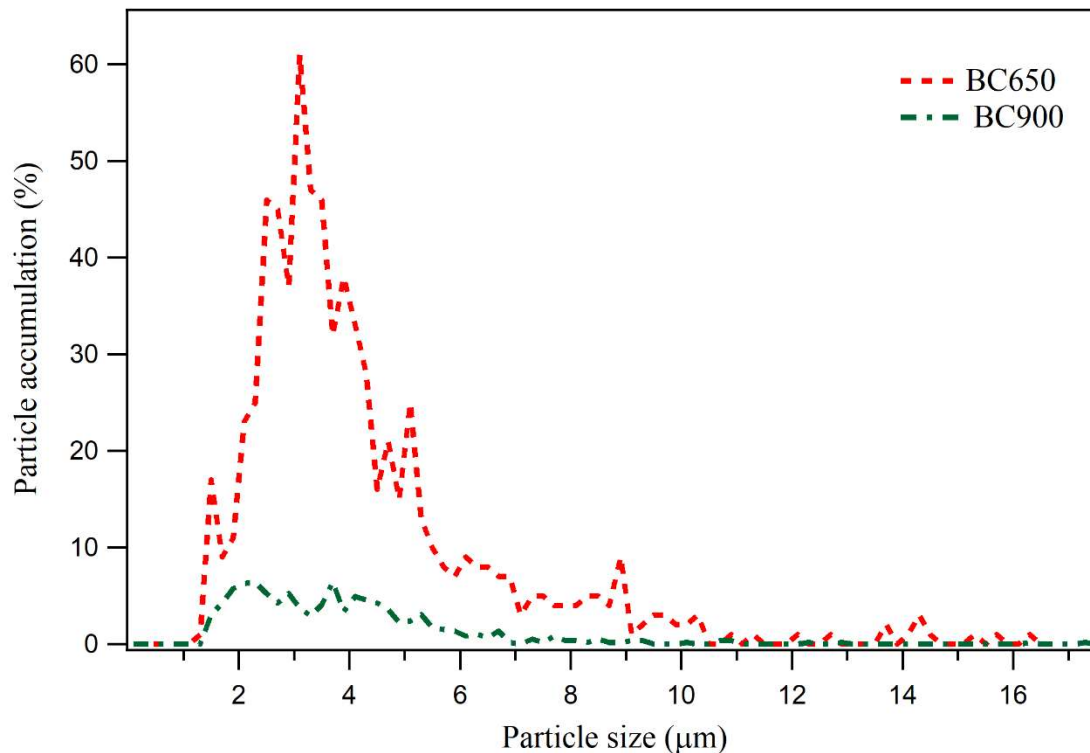


Figure S1: Particle size distribution of biocarbon ball-milled at two different pyrolysis temperature (650 and 900 °C) obtained by image-based particle size analysis

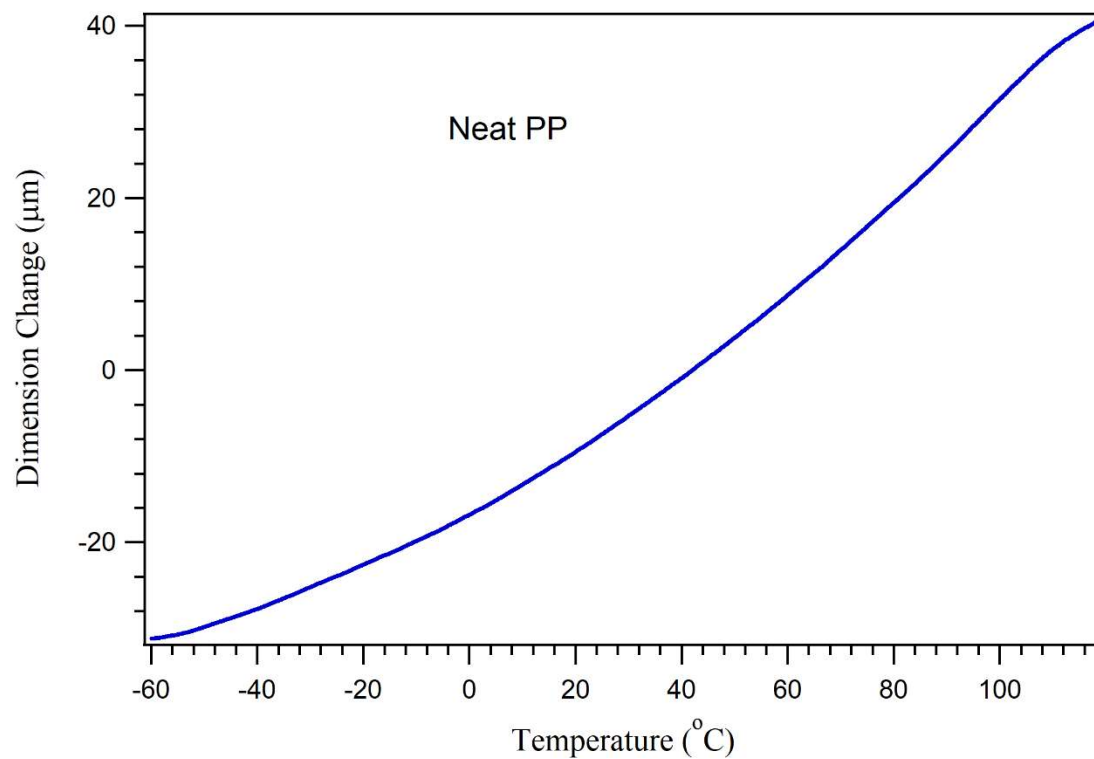


Figure S2: Typical thermal expansion behavior of neat PP in the ND during the second heating runs.
