Thalassemias are genetic blood disorders characterized by decreased hemoglobin production, which occurs in about 280 million people worldwide, with about 439,000 having a severe form of the disease as of 2015 [2]. The primary role of this journal is to publish clinically relevant information that will directly improve the care of patients affected by this disorder. *Thalassemia Reports* was published by PAGEPress and will be published by MDPI as of 8 November 2021 [3].
