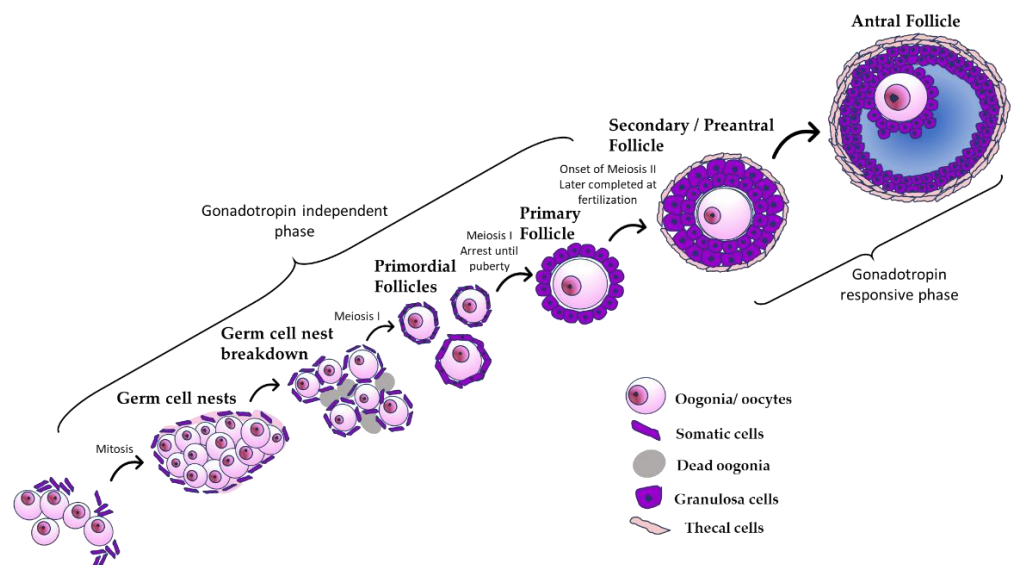

The schematic shows that primordial germ cells form germ cell nests, which subsequently break down to form a finite pool of primordial follicles, starting the process of folliculogenesis. During folliculogenesis, primordial follicles grow and mature into primary follicles, then preantral follicles, and finally antral follicles.
