Aims

The *Journal of Interdisciplinary Research Applied to Medicine* (*JDR_eAM*) is an international, peer-reviewed, open access journal aimed at translating, in clinical settings, health-related research from a range of scientific areas, such as biology, biotechnology and biomedicine as well as physics, statistics, informatics, computer engineering, technology and nano-biomaterials, in addition to neuroscience, psychology, pedagogy and human sciences. It is published online quarterly by MDPI.

JDR_eAM includes articles, essays, contributions, experiences and results from the application of research to medicine. The journal is exclusively published in English and all inclusions are peer-reviewed. These publications are characterized by the originality of their themes and settings, the novelty and interest of their research-based sources, their critical and innovative methodologies and their coverage of national or international scientific debates.
